Targeting graduates in business, engineering, and related fields, this program blends theory with hands-on experience, providing relevant skills for the circular economy.

FReINDs aligns with EU priorities by advancing green transition, promoting innovative teaching, and enhancing digital readiness. The project equips industries—especially SMEs—to adapt IS practices for greater competitiveness and environmental impact, contributing to the EU's climate and digital transformation goals.

Results

- FReINDs Curriculum An Industrial Symbiosis course for socio-economic graduates, covering core IS and circular economy topics, with hands-on experience.
- MOOC Free, open-access IS and Circular Economy course based on the curriculum, available for five years post-project.
